Club Rules

Starting Times:

During match play the draw and starting times for each round will be displayed in the club. No match may be played other than at these times without the prior approval from the Match Committee.

The penalty is disqualification.

Countbacks:

The Match Committee adopts the recommendation of the R & A countback system.

Handicap Grades:

Grade Division Indexes to be set by Match Committee prior to Stroke Play Championship.

Stroke Play Championship: 4 Men's & 3 Ladies' Grades

To be played without handicap over 72 holes on 4 consecutive Saturdays for Men; Ladies best 2 out of 3 - 18 hole rounds over three consecutive weeks. The lowest aggregate score from each grade is 'Champion'.

Match Play Championship (4 Men's & 3 Ladies' Grades)

Men's - A qualifying round of 18 holes 4 grades; played ex-handicap. Best 8 from each grade play through elimination up to final level. If the match is square after 18 holes, play shall continue from No. 1 until a player shall lose a hole. Final to be played on "All Finals Day" as per the calendar. Finals for Men's Senior, Intermediate and Junior, Grades will be over 36 holes. Men's C Grade will play 18 holes. Finals for Ladies Silver and Bronze I over 36 holes, Bronze II over 18 holes.

In the event a finals match is tied, a sudden death play-off will start at the 4^{th} hole, then the 13th, then the 14^{th} until a decision reached.

Handicap Match Play Championship:

Men - A qualifying round of 18 holes to be played on current handicap. Best 8 to qualify and play through elimination up to final level; final played as per calendar. If the match is square after 18 holes, play shall continue from No.1 until a player shall lose a hole. "Played on date in calendar unless alternative dates are set by Match Committee".

Ladies Competitions:

Must have 8 valid players to go ahead with competitions except for LGU, stroke play and match play club championships.

Good Golfing Manners

- 1. Walk quickly between shot, making sure you are well clear of players in your group.
- 2. Do not talk or move close to someone playing a shot.
- 3. Do not play a shot until those in front are out of range.
- 4. When looking for a lost ball, check those behind are not kept waiting. If so, call them through.
- 5. If you fall behind players in front by a complete hole, call those behind you through.
- 6. If you incur a penalty, inform your opponent.
- Do NOT mark your card on greens; do NOT leave trundlers or bags in front of greens; make sure you clear the way for other golfers on greens.
- The golf course is for your enjoyment, please make every effort to keep it in good repair. Keep trundlers and golf cart away from greens and wet areas.
- Correct dress: Do not embarrass yourself and/or your playing partners. Shoes, tee shirts, sports shirts. Dress shorts and long trousers are all acceptable. Singlets, jandals and beach shorts or togs are not.
- 10. Give way to greens staff unless called through.

Reference to Committee in the Rules of Golf means 'Match Committee', not 'General Committee'
